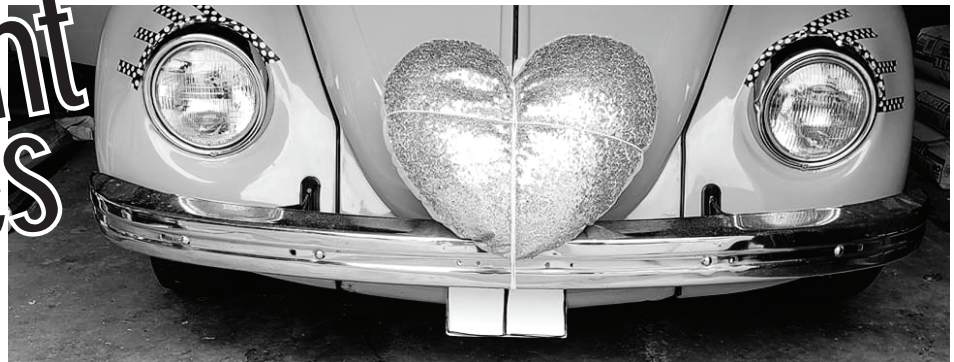


Important Updates
