- a. FHNA efforts to engage with neighbors re their use of the garden – Dean volunteered to work with Mark to draft a letter that will go from FHNA to the neighbors;
- b. Permanent signs in the compost area – prototypes were approved, and Mary Ellen’s beautiful large sign will be erected at 10:00 AM on Saturday, July 18
- c. Protecting the water faucets – it was decided that more sawhorses should be built, hopefully also on Saturday, July 18.
- d. Proposal to add “building recreational fires” as part of the restricted activities (see attached edit (in red)) - approved
- e. Vote on committee rules (attached) – Approved with amendment that voting members must attend 6 out of the last 12 meetings.. Sheila agreed to contact Diane to get old records of garden.
- f. Proposal to ease the slope on the east driveway so that cars do not bottom out with the eventual goal making the driveways one way. Dean proposed a temporary wooden “ramp”, which we will attempt to put in on Saturday, July 18.
- g. MOTION: To continue to post signs, emails and facebook posts reminding people to leash their pets and remove their waste. 7 approved. 1 opposed. Sheila agreed to contact city to see if a pet waste receptacle could be provided.
- h. MOTION: To continue to caution parents through signs, e-mails and/or facebook posts to watch their children. Signs will be posted “Children at play - Drive slowly”. 7 approved
- i. MOTION: to continue to allow cars to park along the grassy edges. “No outlet” sign will be erected 7 approved.
- j. Hoses. MOTION: to remind gardeners to remove and stash their hoses with a small zip tie sign attached to each spigot Hose stand and all the levers are off. 6 approved – We will look into the design and cost of enough simple hose holder stands (ca 125 required) for 2021.
- k. New business
 - ideas to discourage harmful biocides. Agreement to post a list of organic chemicals on facebook/e-mail. Particularly egregious incidents were noted and communication with offending parties are in progress
 - New Gravel needs to be put down on southeast portion of drive.
