## **RESURFACING OF FULLER AVENUE FROM MICHIGAN STREET TO RACE STREET AND FROM MALTA STREET TO LEONARD STREET**

### **UPCOMING PROJECT**

The City of Grand Rapids (City) plans to resurface Fuller Avenue from Michigan Street to Race Street and from Malta Street to Leonard Street in Spring/Summer 2014. The work includes removal and replacement of the top layer of asphalt pavement within the entire project limits. Curb and sidewalk replacement will be minimal and generally limited to intersections where sidewalk ramps will be reconstructed. No underground utility work is planned.
